Last year, our school earned reaccreditation with NAEYC (National Association for the Education of Young Children)! This mark of distinction puts our School in the top 8% of early childhood centers in the U.S. No other area school has this accreditation. We have been accredited since 1989. We are very proud to be an NAEYC school. A team of NAEYC assessors visited in January 2025. They spent several days observing in our classrooms, on the playgrounds and meeting with our Director.

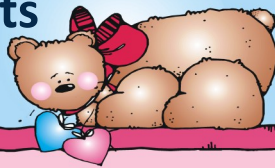
